Statement of Principle

ATOG is committed to protecting the environment and enhancing its business performance through the implementation of an Environmental Management Plan (EMP) that promotes environmental awareness, sustainability, waste reduction, and legal compliance throughout the organisation.

We seek to understand and minimise the environmental impact of all our activities and comply with all applicable legislation; we will also consider environmental impacts that arise out of any changes to our business or the way in which it is carried out.

Implementation

- aspire to implement best environmental practice and reduce its energy and resource consumption whenever practicable;
- provide adequate communication and training to staff where required throughout the organisation to ensure the understanding and implementation of the EMP;
- manage measurable performance targets which shall be established throughout the organisation that support the delivery of business objectives; and
- perform regular audits to ensure that targets are being met.

- provide the financial support and resources necessary in order to ensure that all of its legal obligations with regards to Environmental Management are met;
- work together with government and other stakeholders to ensure that the EMP is fully implemented through top-down commitment; and
